### 1.) Can you provide an overview of the camp?

Kids between the ages of 7-18 years can participate. We also have an evening session planned for Masters.

#### Day Camp:

- We will have 3 groups with a maximum of 21 participants in each group.
- Participants will be grouped by age; however experience and skill level will also be considered in exceptional circumstances.
- Registration is on a first come first served basis.
- Last year we had three instructors on the ice for most sessions and we are planning the same for this year (which should result in a maximum student instructor ration of 7:1).
- Camp activities each day are separated into four sessions: on-ice part 1, player development, conditioning, on-ice part 2
- All groups will receive a minimum of two hours of ice time per day. **We may decide to once again add more ice time for Groups B and C but need total registration numbers in these two groups to exceed 30 participants.**
- **On-ice instructors: we are very pleased to once again have Devrey & Dallas Robbins return as our lead instructors.** The feedback from camp participants in 2008 was (again) very positive and we look forward to another great camp.
- We are in the process of confirming what activities will make up the player development and conditioning activities. We will be making changes driven by feedback provided by participants last year. Activities from the past 2 years included ice breaker & team building, nutrition and mental training, bowling, theatre games, dry land training, conditioning in the park, skating treadmill and ring shooting
- All activities at the 2007 & 2008 Camps were at Twin Arenas or within walking distance. This is also our objective this year.
- A draft schedule has been posted on our web site. As per last year, we likely will have the youngest participants start first (Group A) and the oldest kids start last (Group C).
- A final schedule with complete details of all activities with locations and times will be e-mailed to all participants two weeks prior to the start of camp.

Participants will be supervised during all activities except lunch. If you would like us to provide lunch time supervision please let us know in writing by e-mail ([treasurer@quesnelringette.info](mailto:treasurer@quesnelringette.info)).

#### Masters/Ladies Evening Camp:

- Dates: Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> to Thursday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Time: 8:00PM – 9:30PM
- Program content will be confirmed with instructors with input from participants.
- Minimum registration required to hold the session is 10 participants.
- Cost: \$95.00 (no early registration discount or t-shirt)

### 2.) Do I need to be registered with the BC Ringette Association to participate?

Yes. If you are registered to play Ringette in BC during the 2008-2009 season you are a member of the BCRA and will have insurance coverage during the Camp. If you did not play Ringette in BC during the 2008-2009 season but prior to start of camp you are registered to play Ringette in BC in the 2009-2010 season you will have insurance coverage during the camp.

### 3.) Will you provide food for the participants?

No, all meals are the responsibility of the participants.

We have one hour scheduled each day for the kids to eat lunch and we have booked the meeting room overlooking Rink 1. We also provide an assortment of games in the lunch room to keep the participants busy.

**4.) What provisions do you make for health issues like asthma?**

As requested on the registration form, please ensure we are made aware of any health issues your child may have. We will ensure all camp instructors are aware of any issues.

**5.) What are the payment options and what discounts are offered? Revised March 2009**

**\$50.00 Deposit**

Due to the popularity of the 2008 Camp, we are anticipating that our groups will fill up quickly for the 2009 Camp. To help families budgeting we do not require full payment at time of registration. Complete the registration form and enclose your cheque for \$50.00 and we will reserve your spot (space permitting when we receive your registration). This deposit is non-refundable. Cheque should be made payable to the Quesnel Ringette Association.

Or if you prefer you can make full payment at time of registration.

**Early Registration Deadline and Discount**

If you register and pay in full before May 1, 2009 you will receive a \$20.00 discount off your registration fee.

The Early Registration discount does not apply to Masters registrations.

**Family Discount**

To help families who want to send 2 or more players to Camp we offer an additional discount of \$10.00 for each family member.

The Family Member discount does apply to Masters registrations.

**Additional Notes**

**Final Payment Due Date:** for those families who have registered with the \$50.00 Deposit (and not taken advantage of the Early Registration Discount) final payment is due by August 14, 2009.

**Masters Program:** as detailed above, the Masters Session Fee is a flat \$95.00. No Early Registration Discount is applicable; however the family discount of \$10 does apply.

**6.) Will the camp qualify for the Children's Tax Credit? Yes.**

**7.) What is the cancellation policy?**

A refund of registration fee (less a \$50.00 administration charge) is available if cancellation is received 30 calendar days prior to the start of camp. No refund will be granted if cancellation is received less than 30 days prior to the start of camp. No refunds are available once camp begins.

**8.) I am coming from out of town. Where can I get information on Quesnel?**

Last year we had 12 participants come from outside of the Quesnel area (Prince George and Houston). Some chose to buddy up with other families and make a holiday out of it. Quesnel and area has much to offer a visiting family in late August!
