The Program

The QRA Ringette Summer Ice for 2011 is an ice only format. Participants will receive 2 ice times per day for 5 days. Power skating sessions each day will be lead by a trained professional (Joanne Nadalin). The second ice session each day will be lead by local instructors. Participants will have approximately 2 hours between each ice session when they can eat lunch and relax in the Banquet Room overlooking Rink 1 or in Lebourdais Park. Summer Ice is for individuals between the ages of 7-18 who are passionate about Ringette and are serious about improving their skills. Participants will be grouped according to age and ability.

QRA Summer Ice Philosophy

Our goal is to provide your child with a high caliber of instruction. Our priority is to ensure that all participants, regardless of ability, skate away from our summer ice with increased confidence in their skills and a greater understanding and passion for this wonderful sport.

Overview of Typical Day

Each day is broken into 2 sessions:

- 1.) Ice Time 1: power skating
- 2.) Ice Time 2: ring skills and game play
